Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates on behalf of T&L.

Pound I/I

Expecting to review the final design plans this month. The stream crossing permits have been submitted. Hoping to go to Bid in the Spring or Sumer.

Lower Bold Camp

The project should be complete by the end of this month. The project has gone over contract time and the contractor will reimburse the PSA for any further costs for inspection and construction administration.

Pound WWTP Upgrades

Slowly progressing and still having material delays.

Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates on behalf of Lane Group

Banner Sewer

We were awarded an additional \$1.3 million in grant money from DHCD Supplementals. We are working with ARC to get more money shifted from Glamorgan project to the Banner project. DEQ is wrapping up The Environmental. We are working with the Town of Coeburn to get their side of the project ready to Bid.

Pound Water Treatment Plant Improvements

Was advertised last week in the paper. March 5th is the scheduled Bid opening date.

Pound System-Wide Improvements 2023

Has been submitted to the Health Department for final approval of the Construction Permit. Should receive approval back within 30 to 60 days and go to Bid.

Appalachia Elementary School Sewer

We are working with the Engineer and Mountain Empire to make sure we have all our flows accounted for. The plan is to have everything to pump to Appalachia, but we must make sure the flows support a Pump Station and won't go septic sitting there.

Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates for Mattern & Craig

Pound River Interceptor

Waiting on the Environmental. The design is wrapping up. We are close to starting the Easement process.

St. Paul Interconnect Study

The PER has been submitted to Rural Development and comments have been received. The Environmental is underway. Once all the agencies respond, it will be submitted back to Rural Development for approval. Upon approval, we hope to see some further action with the Town of St. Paul and Russell County where we approved the Resolution to have some more discussions about wholesale water.

Bear Creek Community Water

Should be finished within the next few weeks. The Environmental for the additional work is closing on the 12th and once this happens, they can finish the final four connections.

Pound - Pilkenton Peak & Highland Avenue

We had the Pre-Construction Conference and construction is slated to start on the 21st near the Post Office, on the Highland Avenue side near the Fire Department, and go that way first and tie into Bold Camp. Then they will go back and start the work at the Water Plant and go onto US 23.
