Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates on behalf of T&L.

Pound I/I

Had a call July 31st with US Fish and Wildlife Service and Army Corps of Engineers where we discussed the Big Sandy Cray Fish and made some good progress on the Environmental Process. Finishing Design which is about 99% complete. Awaiting Environmental. Hoping to Bid late this year or the beginning of next year.

Pound WWTP Upgrades

The project is about 60% complete per budget. Some big-ticket items should be arriving soon. Project should wrap up by the end of the year.

Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates on behalf of Lane Group

Banner Sewer

We have received our final funding from ARC and we have our Environmental clearance from all the parties involved. The Town of Coeburn is submitting everything they need for their Bid as well. We are expecting a meeting with the Town of Coeburn within the next 45 days to discuss moving forward with the project they have in town that runs parallel with this project.

Pound Water Treatment Plant Improvements

Holding with VDH for potentially more grant money. Should know within the next month if we will receive possibly another \$400,000 grant money.

Pound System-Wide Improvements 2023

Still waiting on the Environmental for the Big Sandy Cray Fish. We have 1 Easement to get done. Should be ready to Bid by mid Fall.

Appalachia Elementary School Sewer

All the information has been sent back to ARC and hope to see a contract issued for execution by the County soon.

Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates for Mattern & Craig

Pound River Interceptor

Plans and Specs are complete. Still waiting on the Environmental.

St. Paul Interconnect Study

We do have verbal approval of the Environmental Report from Rural Development and should receive the letter soon. The PER will get resubmitted since the Environmental is approved. Once both are approved together, we will move to application for funds for construction. We will have to meet again with the Town of St. Paul to make sure everyone agrees to moving forward with the project.

Director Cody McElroy submitted project updates for PSA

Pound - Pilkenton Peak & Highland Avenue

Contractors are on the four-lane coming south back toward Southfork and are about to tie into the Southfork intersection within the next couple of weeks. They have laid across the four-lane toward the Town side of Southfork, through casing pipe, and will start next week with pressure reducing vault. Project should be done within 45 days. We are hoping to see the water loss go down more once the project is complete.

BOARD ACTION ITEMS

Currently, the PSA has four (4) accounts with the Virginia Investment Pool (VIP) which include our debt service reserve, a Dominion sinking fund, a General Reserve, and a Capital Offset account.

With the number of projects, we are currently undertaking with Pound and our existing systems, our capital account for projects is stretched thin often in between reimbursements by the respective funding agencies. We want to take the approximately \$400,000 in the General Reserve and Capital Offset accounts and transfer those to our capital account to help our cash flow. This will allow us to pay contractors and consultants in a timelier manner while we await reimbursement from agencies. The other alternative would be a separate line of credit, but that would cause the PSA to incur interest charges.

A motion was made by JH Rivers, and seconded by Bob Adkins, to authorize the staff to transfer the funds in the General Reserve and Capital Offset accounts to the Capital Account to assist with cashflow for projects. The vote was as follows.
